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
1. Book Review:

a) 15 b) 18




3. Solve me if you can:

6. "Nature's Art Gallery"

Objective : To observe and appreciate the beauty of nature through scientific

observation and artistic expression.

Materials:

Notebook Pencils and erasers Colored pencils, crayons, or markers Camera (optional) Instructions:

- Go on a nature walk and observe the different plants, animals, and landscapes that you encounter. Take note of their colors, shapes, textures, and patterns. If you have a camera, you can also take pictures of the things that catch your eye.
- Choose at least three things that you found interesting or beautiful on your walk. It could be a flower, a leaf, a rock, a bird, a butterfly, or anything else that you liked.
- Use your notebook and pencil to make a scientific drawing of each of the things you chose. This means that you should draw them as accurately as possible, paying attention to their proportions, details, and colors. You can also add labels to show what each thing is called and any observations you made.
- After you have finished your scientific drawings, use your colored pencils, crayons, or markers to create a second version of each drawing, but this time you can add your own creative touches. You can use any colors you like, and you can also add patterns, designs, or other elements to make your drawings more artistic.
