### 1. News paper preparation

A newspaper is a periodical publication containing written information about current events and is often typed in black ink with a white or gray background . Let's enjoy our Summer vacations by making a colourful newspaper (4 -5 pages) of our own. You can collect /paste pictures and write information about

- a) Tourist places
- b) My Role Model

- c) Moral value based stories  
d) News Create one special page in which you can mention about a few future gadgets which can be of great help to us in the year 2050.

2. **Make a plant vocabulary** of at least 20 words related to plant life. Draw or paste pictures of the words and write what they mean.

For example Agriculture ----- the growing of plants/ crops and livestock

Bamboo----- the tallest grass used to make a variety of things.

3. Find out the following about any two states mentioned- Himachal Pradesh, Rajasthan, Kerala, Assam. Also present your findings and draw or paste pictures on an A3 sheet.

- a) Physical features and climatic condition
- b) The capital of the state and the language spoken
- c) A famous monument
- d) Cuisine and any other facts related to its culture and tradition.

4. Design a beautiful **Book Cover** for the book that you enjoyed reading and then write the review for that book. (You may use ruled/plain A4 sheets.)

The **Book Review** can consist of:

- The name of the book along with that of the author, the illustrator and the publisher.
- The setting of the story e.g. 'Matilda'- This story is about a girl with an unusual power who lived in England. (When, Where)
- Main idea of the story.
- What you liked and disliked about the story, or the characters in it, giving reasons.
- Anything in the story that touched you or you found interesting/funny/exciting/scary.
- You could compare the present story with a similar story you may have read earlier, and can comment on the way the story ended and how you felt in the end.

5. Collect 5 packed food items that are available in the market. Make a list of nutrients found in them. Find out the amount of each of the nutrients present in them. Note down your observations based on which food items are good or not good for your health. (You may use A4 sheets.)

6. Find out the pin codes of 5 states (Jammu, Delhi, Chandigarh, Mumbai and Banglore). Now do as directed on A4 sheet.

- a) Write the number names for each pin code (Using both Indian and International Value system).
- b) Arrange the pin code in ascending order.
- c) Find out The population of Gujarat and Assam and write numerals in words (both Indian and International value system).
